

A Final Note

The Bible addresses the assurance of salvation in two ways: First, we look away from ourselves to Christ and His life, death, and resurrection on behalf of sinful people. Second, we look at ourselves to see if God has given us spiritual life. The first emphasizes what the Bible calls “justification” (that all who come to God by faith in Christ are accepted as righteous before Him because of who Jesus is and what He did, though they are sinners); the second emphasizes “regeneration” (that all believers have received visible and discernible life from God Himself). *Wasted Faith* is a close look at the second of these.
